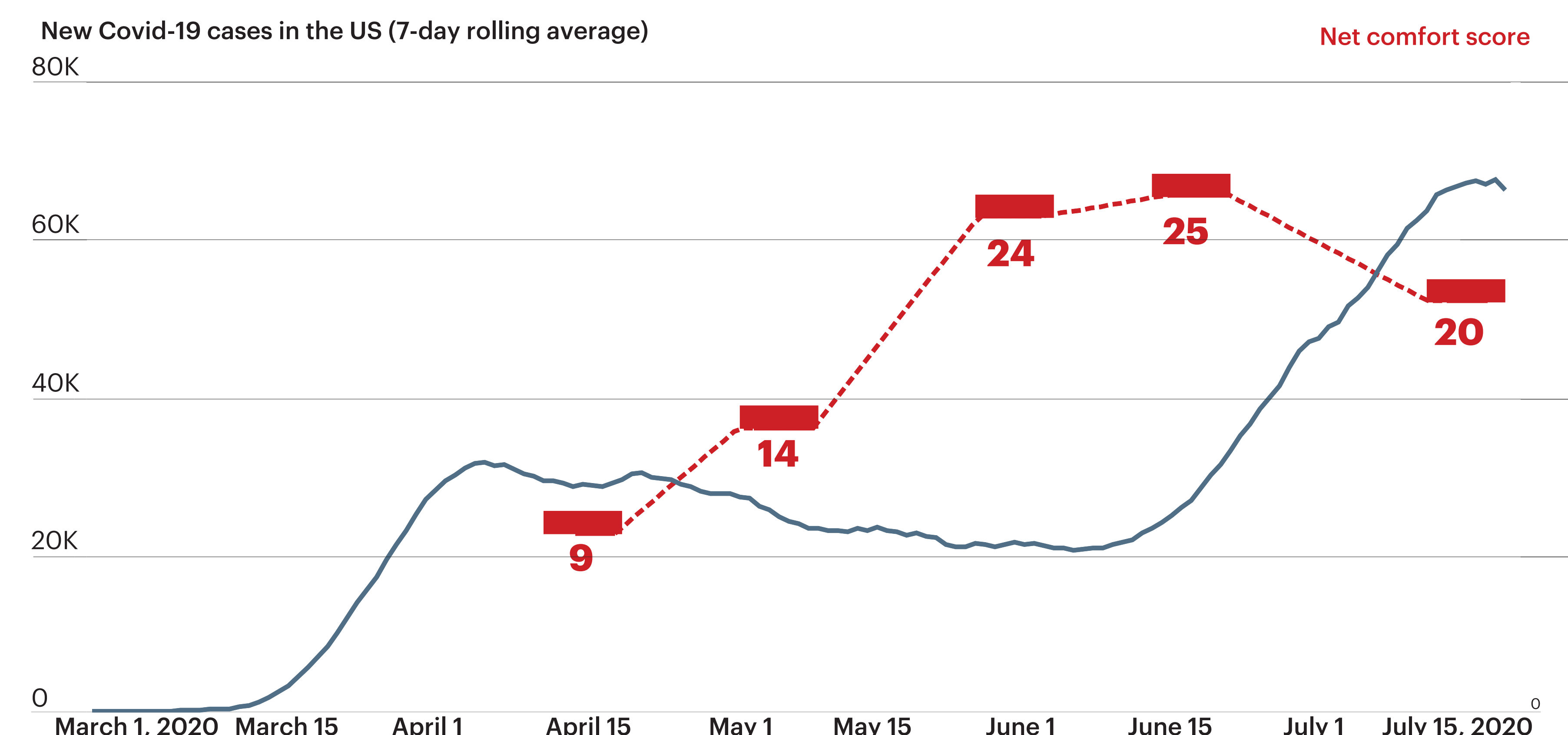


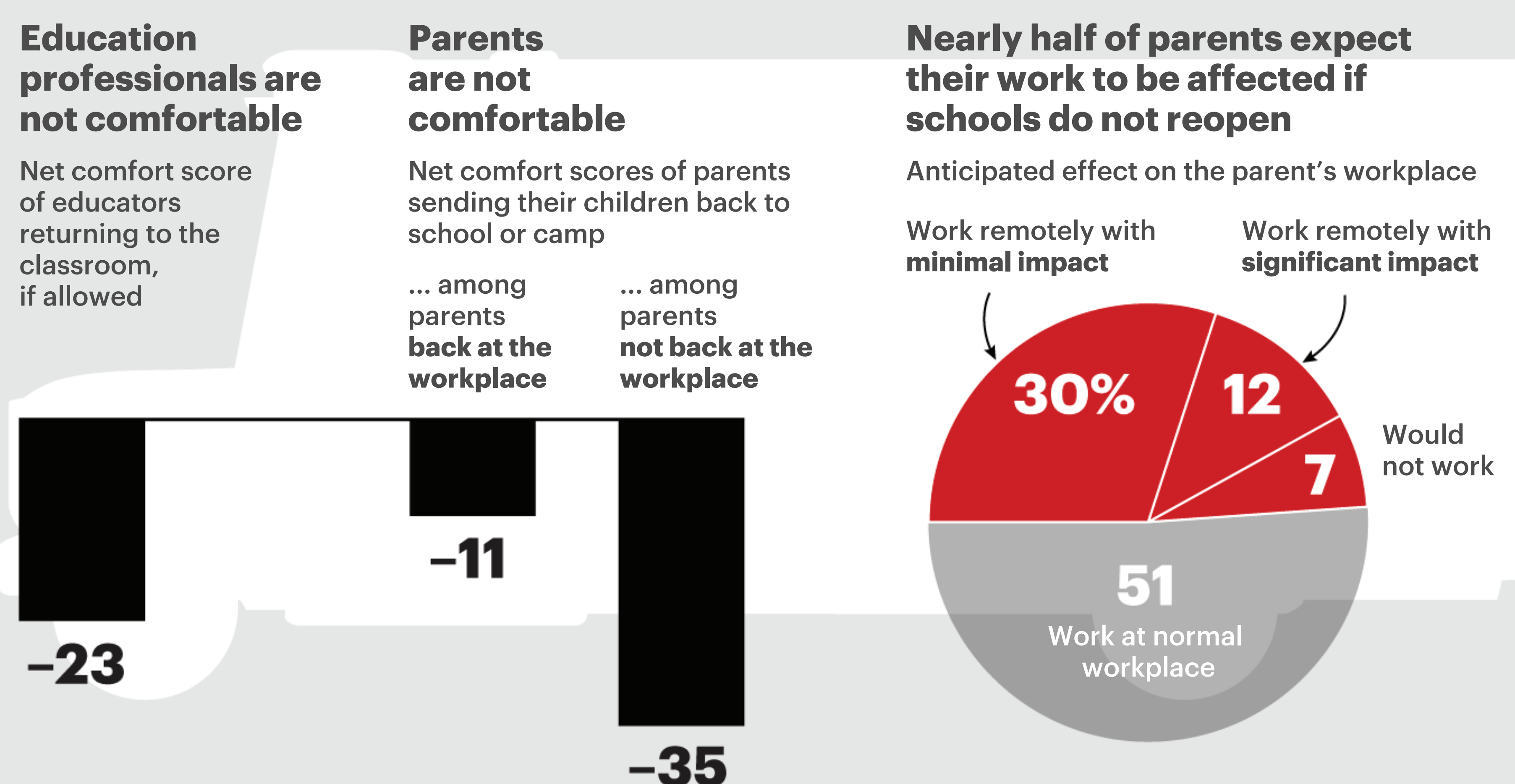
# Back-to-Work Warning Signs: Rising Covid-19 Cases and the Classroom Crisis

**Americans are getting less comfortable returning to the workplace**



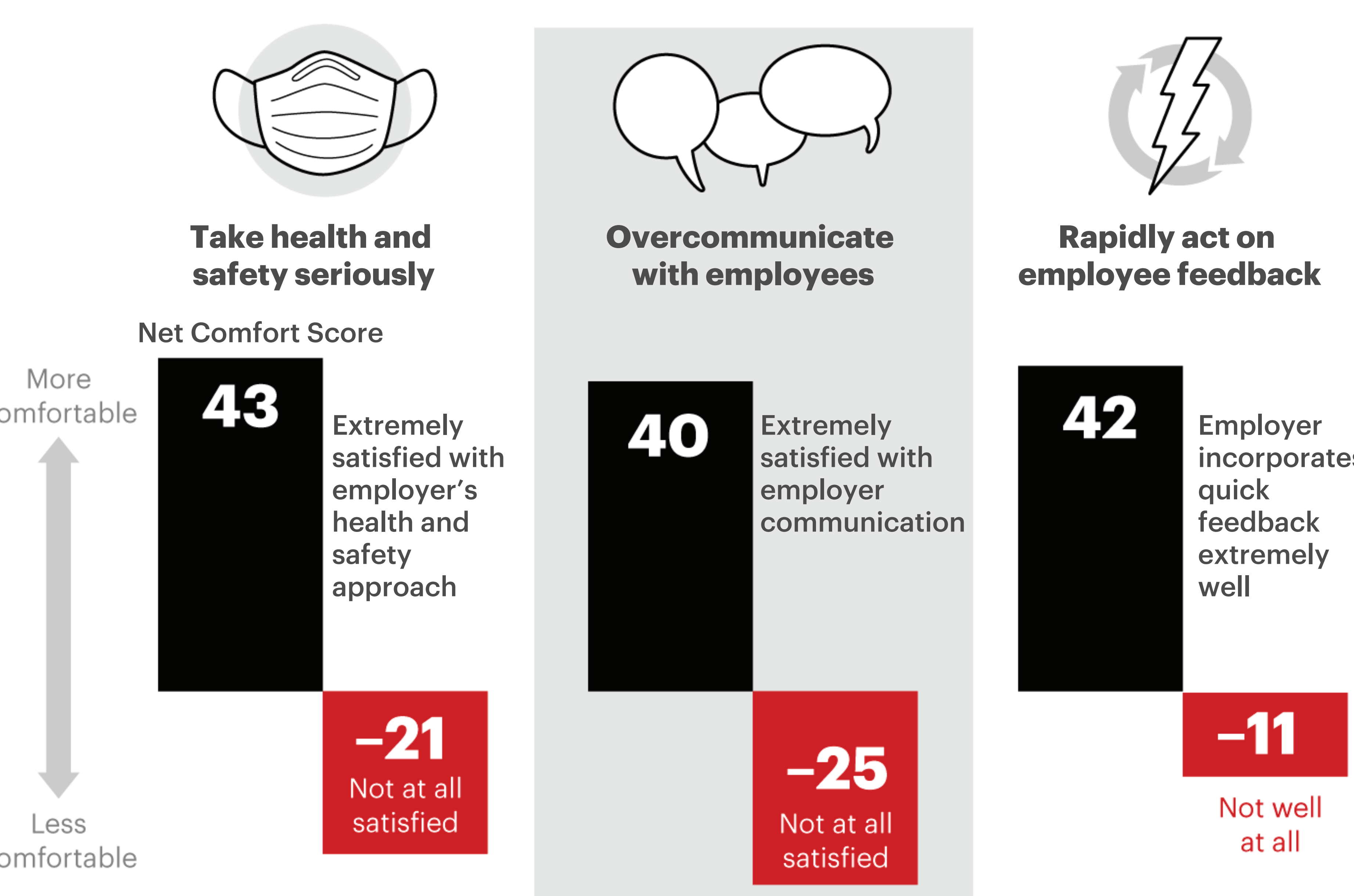

## Returning to school remains a challenge



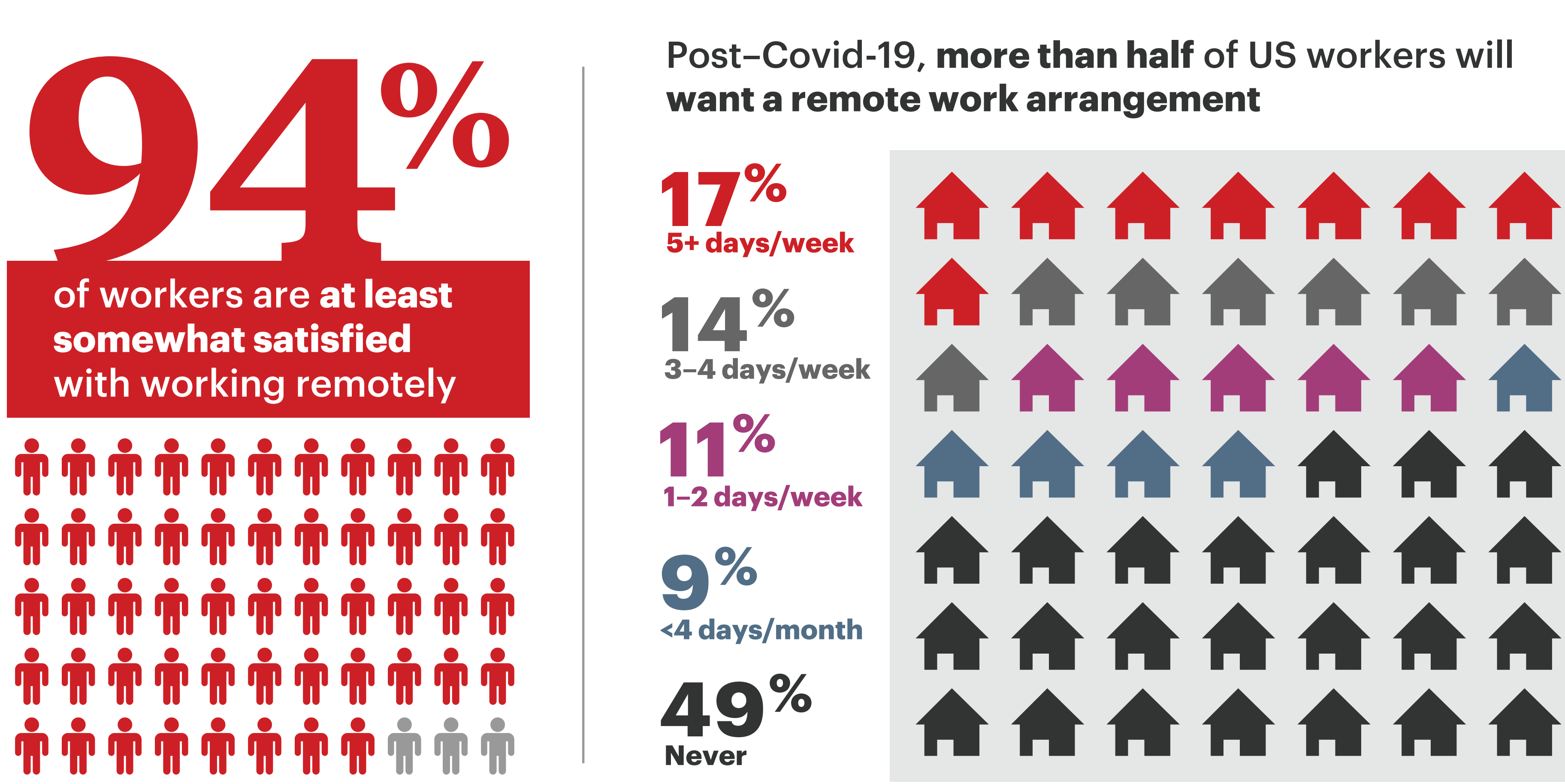

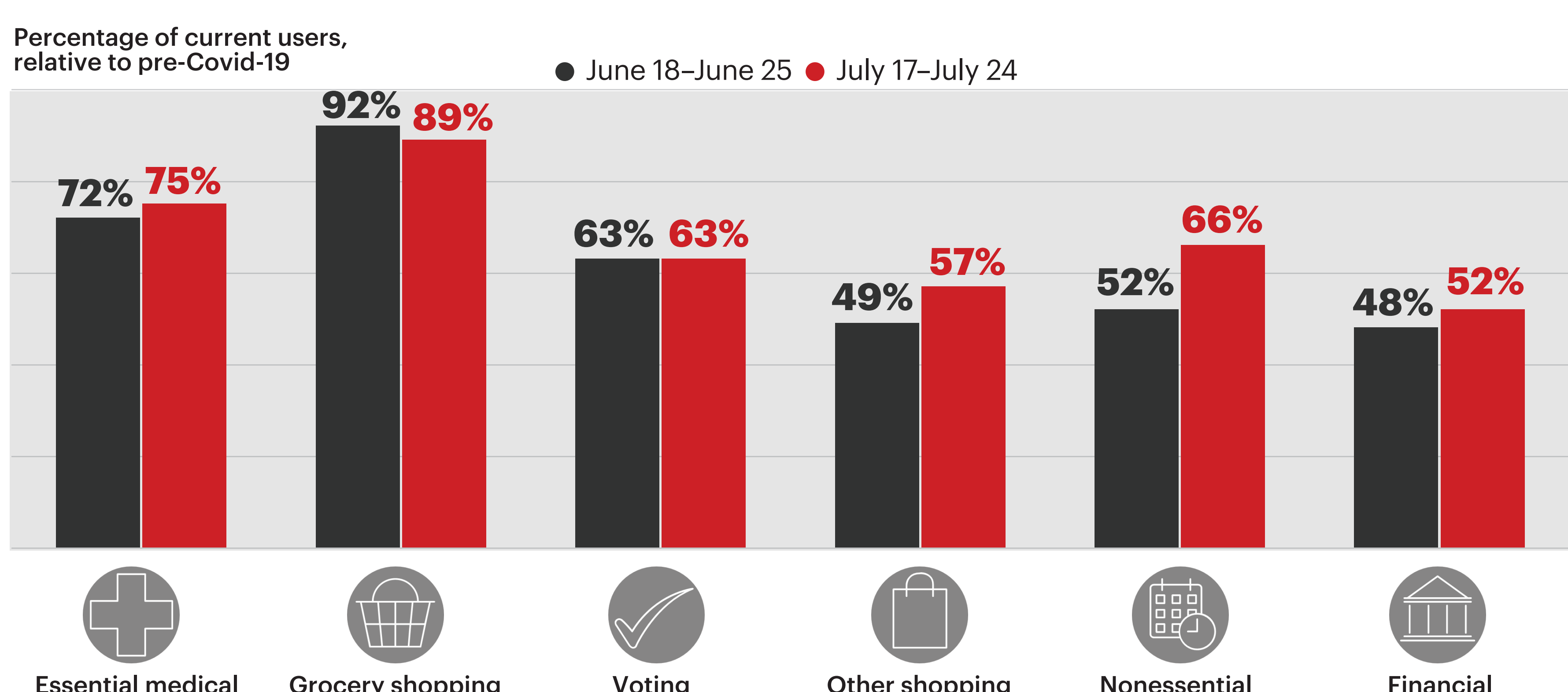

### Remote work is here to stay, but not for everyone

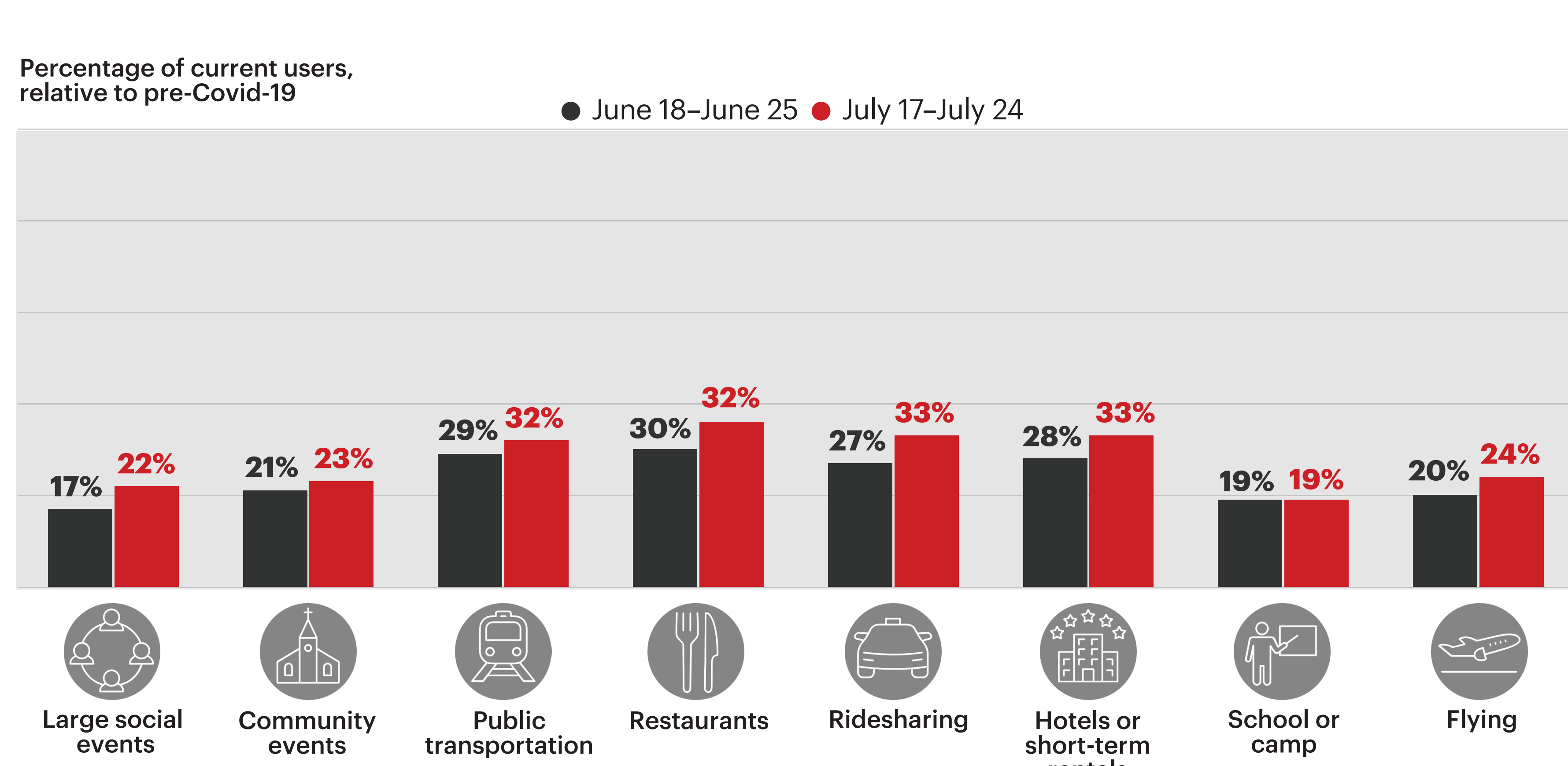


## More Americans are resuming their pre-pandemic activities

A majority have engaged in lower-risk activities that allow for distancing ...

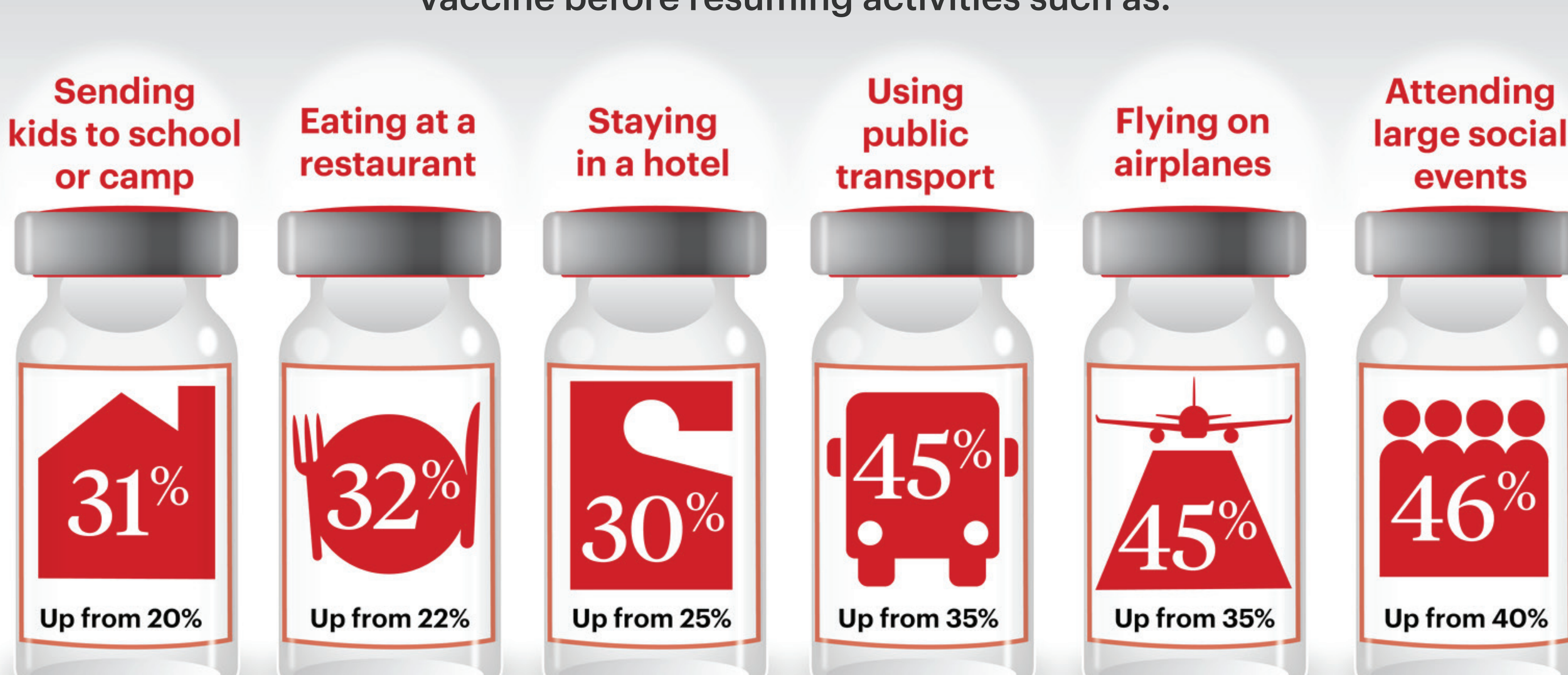


... but many are hesitant to resume discretionary or higher-risk activities
